
Creative Living Series

Will Steger Adventurer, Arctic Explorer, Advocate September 21, 2023

Will Steger is best known for his legendary explorations spanning 50 years, including some of the most significant polar expeditions in history. Hiking and dog sledding across continents of ice, exploring the unknown footstep by footstep, he is an eyewitness to the changes overtaking the polar regions of our planet. He has become a formidable voice calling for understanding and preserving the Arctic and the Earth. He built his Wilderness Center by hand deep in the Minnesota woods to inspire in the next generation a passion for discovery and innovative thinking. Steger shares stunning photographs and videos from his expeditions,

explaining the implications of compelling data and satellite imagery. While the issue is critical and the presentation dramatic, his message is one of hope and empowerment. Steger is a recipient of National Geographic's rarely bestowed John Oliver La Gorce Medal and the National Geographic Adventure Lifetime Achievement Award. How does a boy from Coalwood, West Virginia, grow up to become not only a NASA astronaut trainer but also a best-selling author? Homer Hickam describes the journey in his coming-of-age memoir *Rocket Boys*, a *New York Times* #1 best-seller that inspired the film *October Sky*, starring Jake Gyllenhaal. Hickam wrote other memoirs in what became the "Coalwood" series after retiring as an aerospace engineer at NASA where he worked on projects including the Hubble Space Telescope and the International Space Station. His other best-selling novels include the World War II-era "Josh Thurlow" series, the young adult sci-fi series *Helium-3*, the adult thriller *The Dinosaur Hunter*, the romance *Red Helmet*, and his latest international bestseller *Carrying Albert Home*. Homer has spoken all over the world, inspiring millions to "aim high!"
